Nomination petitions of candidates for members of the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 501, Counties of Bond, Clinton, Fayette, Jefferson, Madison, Marion, Montgomery, St. Clair, and Washington, State of Illinois, may be obtained at the Office of the President of Kaskaskia College and at the Safety and Security Desk, Community College District No. 501, 27210 College Road, Centralia, Illinois.

The Office of the President, Administration Building of Kaskaskia College, 27210 College Road, Centralia Illinois, will be open between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday beginning Monday, December 14, 2020 and ending Monday, December 21, 2020 for the purpose of accepting candidate petitions for the consolidated election to be held on April 6, 2021 for the office of Trustee of Kaskaskia College. Please follow the Covid-19 requirements for visiting Kaskaskia College as listed on the College's website.

A Statement of Candidacy and a receipt showing that the candidate has filed a Statement of Economic Interests with the County Clerk (as required by the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act) must be attached to each candidate's petition.

The dates for filing objections to nomination papers are December 22 and 23, 2020 and January 4, 5 and 6, 2021. The Office of the President, Administration Building of Kaskaskia College, 27210 College Road, Centralia Illinois, will be open between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on these dates for the purpose of accepting objections to nomination papers.

The election, which is to be held on Tuesday, April 6, 2021, is for the purpose of electing three (3) members of the Board of Trustees for a full term of six (6) years, and one (1) member of the Board of Trustees for an unexpired term of 2 (2) years.
